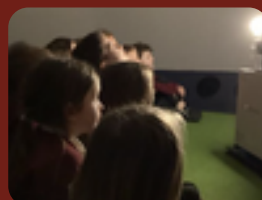

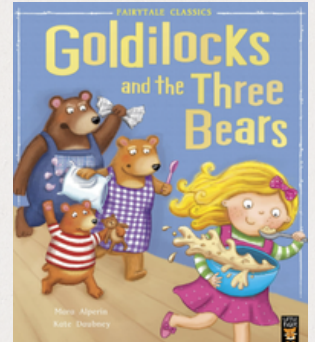
Oak Class - A Book Review of Goldilocks and The Three Bears

I would rate it 3 stars because I liked some parts and not others.

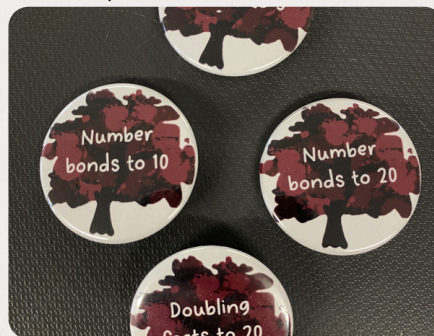


Marvellous Maths

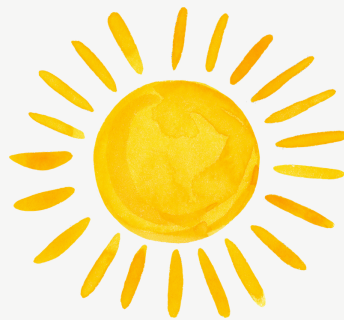
