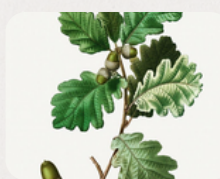

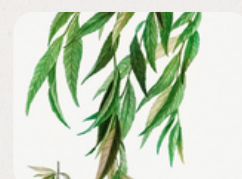

Message from the Headteacher

You may be aware that, for many years, we have worked with TLE to support the delivery of our PE lessons. Government funding has been used to ensure high-quality PE provision, while also enabling our teaching staff to learn from the coaches and their planning so they can confidently deliver equally high-quality lessons themselves. Although we were already preparing to take this on fully, the government has now withdrawn the grant from the end of July, with only transitional funding available until December. As a result, we will be ending our contract with TLE, and from September our class teachers will be delivering PE as part of our whole-school curriculum. We have greatly valued our partnership with TLE and have been fortunate to work with a number of positive and dedicated staff. We will continue to collaborate with them wherever possible in the future. TLE will still be running their summer sports camp here as usual this year, and going forward, families will be able to access these camps at various other locations (details are included on the final page of this newsletter). We are also planning to introduce new after-school sports clubs from September. In the meantime, we hope the children continue to enjoy their PE lessons with Mr Lyes over the coming weeks.



Lunchtime Book Club

Last week saw our first Lunchtime Book Club take place. The children had the opportunity to come and use the library, talk about and listen to new books, as well as being supported to find new authors. This will be taking place every Thursday. Thank you to Mrs Kelland for helping us with this and to all our reading volunteers, who give up their time each week.

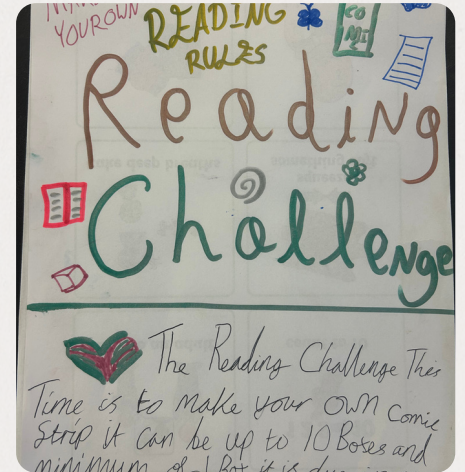


Reading Challenge

'To design your own comic strip'

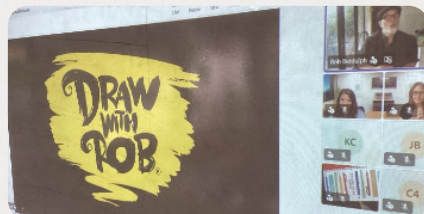
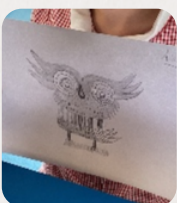
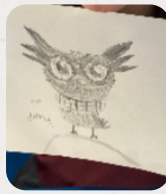
Comic templates will be sent home next week and the deadline is **Monday 13th July**. Please hand completed comics to class teachers.
