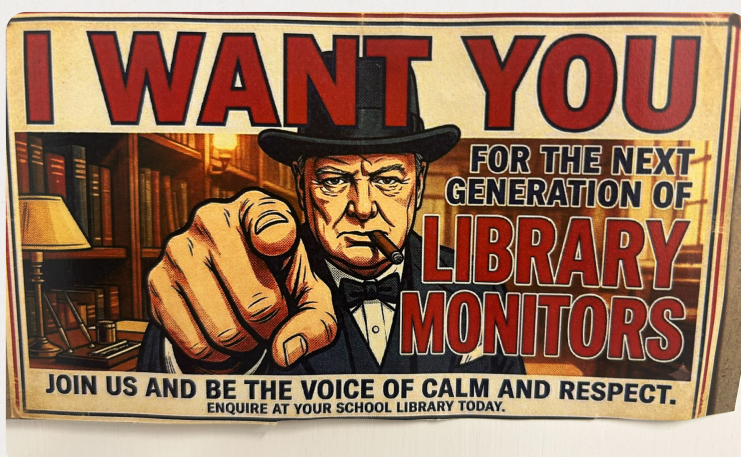
OPAL
